

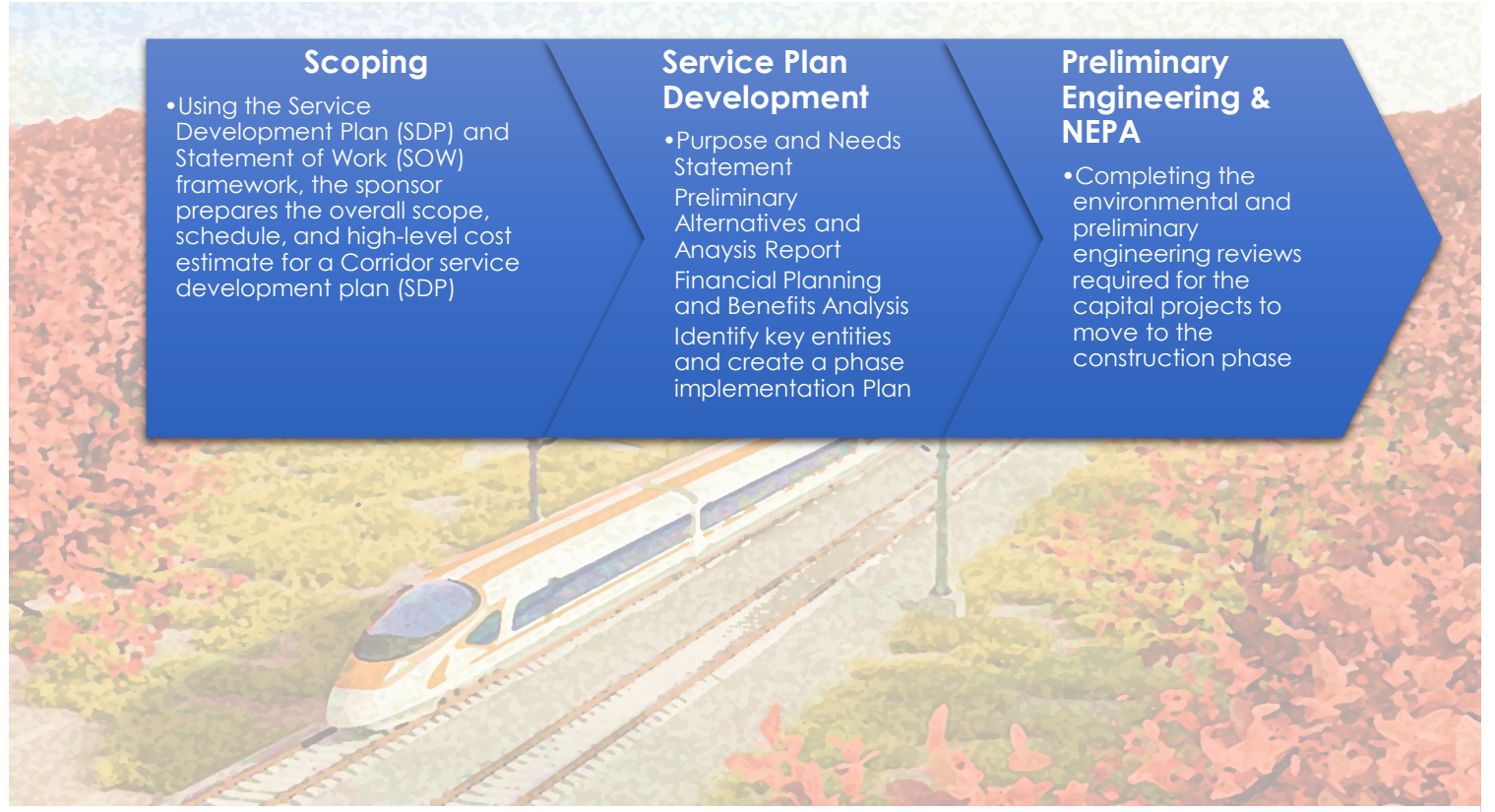


Episode 30 Downloadable: 3 Things to Know About FRA's Corridor ID Program for Passenger Rail

What is the purpose of the Corridor ID?

The Corridor ID program marks a major milestone in the USDOT's efforts to expand intercity passenger rail development across the U.S. As a part of the Bipartisan Infrastructure law (or BIL), the Secretary of Transportation established the Corridor ID and Development program to facilitate the development of new passenger rail corridors. The Corridor ID program commits to funding projects from conception to construction.
